Registration & Payment

Registration for Fun & Faith Summer Camp is confirmed once the [online registration form](#) has been submitted and full payment has been received. Please note that all fees are non-refundable unless otherwise stated. Payments can be made conveniently via e-transfer, cheques or cash.

Meals & Nutrition

Lunch and snacks will be provided by the centre as part of our camp program. All meals are prepared to be nut-free, child-friendly, and thoughtfully planned to offer balanced and nutritious options. To ensure the safety and well-being of every child, we kindly ask families to inform us of any allergies or dietary restrictions in advance. In some cases, families may be asked to provide alternative food to accommodate specific dietary needs.

What to Bring

- Comfortable clothing & running shoes

Lunch and snacks are provided—no need to pack food unless instructed. Please ensure that all personal items are clearly labeled to prevent loss or mix-ups.

Health & Safety

Our camp maintains a strict peanut-free environment to ensure the safety of all children. We kindly ask families to keep children at home if they are feeling unwell to help prevent the spread of illness. Our staff are trained in first aid and are prepared to respond promptly to any health or safety needs that may arise during camp activities.

Field Trips

Families will receive advance notice for all field trips to ensure proper preparation and communication. Transportation and supervision will be provided by camp staff, and all activities will be conducted in accordance with established safety guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for every child.

Photo & Video Policy

Photos and videos may be taken for communication and promotional purposes. No identifying information will be shared without consent.

Faith-Based Activities

Throughout the camp, children will have the opportunity to engage in meaningful faith-based activities, including listening to Bible stories, singing worship songs, and participating in prayer time. These moments are designed to be joyful, age-appropriate, and inspiring, helping children grow in their understanding of God's love and build a personal connection with Him. As it is written, *"Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."* (Matthew 19:14)

Behavior Policy

All participants are expected to demonstrate respectful behavior toward peers and staff, comply with staff instructions, and engage in all activities in a safe and appropriate manner. Safe participation is required at all times. The camp reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any participant whose behavior is deemed unsafe, non-compliant, or disruptive to the well-being of others.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

All children must be signed in and out by a parent or authorized guardian each day. Only individuals listed as authorized contacts will be permitted to pick up a child. For the safety and security of all participants, identification may be required at the time of pick-up. Late pick-up may result in additional fees in accordance with camp policy.

Subsidy Support

Limited subsidy available for pastor and missionary families. All inquiries are confidential.

Emergency Procedures

First aid will be administered by trained staff in the event of a minor injury or illness. Parents or guardians will be notified promptly of any incidents involving their child. In the case of a serious injury or medical emergency, emergency services will be contacted immediately, and parents will be informed as soon as possible.

Registration & Payment

Full payment or deposit is required at the time of registration to secure your child's spot and all fees are non-transferable to another child.

Cancellation & Refunds

Cancellations made more than four weeks before the camp start date will receive a full refund minus a non-refundable administrative fee. Cancellations made between two to four weeks before the camp start date will receive a 50% refund of the total camp fee. No

refunds will be issued for cancellations made less than two weeks before the camp start date.

After Camp Begins

No refunds or credits will be provided for absences (including illness), late arrivals or early withdrawals, or dismissal due to behavioural concerns.

Medical Exceptions

Refund requests for medical reasons may be considered only with a doctor's note, and approved cases may receive a prorated refund at the centre's discretion.

Camp Cancellation by the Centre

If the camp is cancelled by the centre due to unforeseen circumstances, a full refund will be issued.

Program Changes

The centre reserves the right to make changes to the program, schedule, or activities as necessary.
